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About

Heartless is a Heart tribute band based in Tinley Park, Illinois, bringing the music of Heart to theater and festival stages across the Midwest. The show centers on the Wilson sisters' catalog, drawing from the full Heart discography from the 1970s to today.

The set covers the range people expect from Heart, from acoustic material like Dog and Butterfly to harder-driving songs like Barracuda. Familiar titles including Magic Man, What About Love, and Crazy on You are part of the show, along with songs Heart has covered from classic rock artists such as Led Zeppelin and The Who.

Heartless is known for renditions that stay close to the original recordings, with a performance built around the driving rhythms, guitar riffs, and signature vocal style associated with Heart. The band also weaves in Heart's history and backstories behind some of the best-known songs, giving buyers a tribute set with both strong song recognition and added context for fans.

For buyers programming classic rock, theater tribute nights, or festival slots, Heartless offers a clearly defined Heart-focused show with material that spans decades of the band's catalog.
